





<u>It's all about Pixels</u> Digital Photography –History

- 1969 Charge-Coupled Device (CCD) semiconductor invented
- 1973 Fairchild Semiconductor releases the first Imagecapturing CCD at .01 Megapixels (100 x 100)
 - (A modern 10 Megapixel camera has 1000 times the density)
- 1986 Kodak develops the first Megapixel sensor
 - (Current cameras have 20+ Megapixels)
- 1988 JPEG standard developed (Joint Photographic Experts Group)
 - Lossy Compression
 - Compression Ratio is Adjustable



Digital Pictures are Computer Files

- Basic Organizational Tool is <u>File Explorer</u>
 - Create a folder Infrastructure to store the Pictures
 - Move (or Copy) Pictures among folders





- .jpg, (.jpe, .jpeg)

- File Format Converters
 - PixConverter, Pixillion
- Picture Viewers (Imaging Software)
 - Microsoft Photos, Google Photos, Photo Gallery, Faststone, Picasa

Phone-Photo Statistics*

- Average smartphone user takes 150 photos/month (5/day)
 - Under 25 years old 250 photos/month
 - More recent estimate of users in the USA only 20/day
- Apple phone users 185/month
- Android phone users 111/month (less expensive/capable devices)
- Male Android user takes the least at 90/month
- Average smartphone has 630 pictures on it (and 24 videos)
- Women take 47% more photos than men
- Men take 15% more videos than women




Association can be changed in <u>Settings – Apps – Default Apps</u>

How to Select Multiple Item

(for Move or Copy)

Contiguous Items



- Select the first item
- Hold the Shift-key down, and select the last item

Non-Contiguous Items



- Select the first item
- Hold down the Ctrl-key and select the second item
- Still holding down the Ctrl-key select all other items

- Ccleaner –Tools-Duplicate Finder (duplicate file names)
- Duplicate File Remover (Microsoft App store)
 - Operation not quite obvious
- Use File Explorer –Sort by:
 - Date Created, Date Taken, Date Modified
 - Size (look for files with exact sizes)
- Clone Files Checker
- Search Everything (Ninite.com or FileHippo.com)
- Duplicate Cleaner Pro
- Duplicate Sweeper
- Duplicate Photo Finder and Remover
- Duplicate Photos Fixer Pro
- Form Good Habits –"Organize as you Go"



- Scanner (Pictures, Documents, Slides)



Google Photos



- Free Photo Storage and Sharing Service (Launched 2015)
 - <u>Unlimited</u> Storage for Pictures 16 megapixels and Videos up to 1080p Resolution. (High Quality)
- Users can search for things in the photos
 - People, Places, or Things
- Over 500 Million Users
- Over 1.2 Billion photos uploaded daily
- Mobile Apps available for Android and iOS
- Sync with mobile device to automatically backup pictures




From an Android Device

- Connect the phone to the computer using USB*
- Pull down the Notifications bar
- Tap "USB charging this device Tap for more options"
- Tap "Transfer files"
- Find your phone in "This PC" in File Explorer
- Open the phone
- Open "Internal shared storage"
- Open "DCIM" and then Open "Camera"
- Using drag & drop, move pictures to your "Pictures" folder
- For attachments, in Internal memory Open "Pictures" and move your pictures to your Pictures folder in This PC




