

"Free Up Space" Tools to Clean Up the Main Memory Drive by Microsoft

- Not able to install important Windows updates,
 - PC's performance may be affected.
- Some ways to free up space to keep the PC up to date and running smoothly.
- These suggestions are listed in order, so
 - start with the first one,
 - see if that helps,
 - and then continue to the next one if it doesn't.

To check the total disk space:

- select 'File Explorer' from the taskbar,
- select 'This PC' on the left side Navigation Bar.




'Checking' Total Disk Space In File Explorer.

- 4. Make Note of the Free GB. (379 GB free)


Adjust appearance & performance

- Windows 10 includes many visual effects, such as:
 - animations
 - and shadow effects.
- They also use additional system resources and slow down the PC.
- Especially if the PC has a smaller amount of memory (RAM).
- To adjust the visual effects in Windows:
- 1. In the search box on the taskbar, type 'performance'.
- 2. Select 'Adjust the appearance and performance of Windows'.
- 3. On the Visual Effects tab, select Adjust for best performance.
- 4. Click on 'Apply'.
- **5. Restart** the PC and see if that speeds up the PC.



Adjust Appearance and Performance

- 1. Type 'Performance' in the search bar.
- 2. Click on 'Performance Monitor' app.



Storage Sense by Microsoft

- How to remove temporary files using the Settings app.
 - manually or automatically.
- It will automatically remove files no longer needed.
 - those files that apps store on the PC to hold information temporarily,
 - those leftover files after installing a new version of software,
 - upgrade logs, (log files that are created when upgrades the OS)
 - error reporting, (logs written by the operating system due to errors)
 - temporary Windows installation files.
- These files won't cause any issues:
 - but they can grow rapidly
 - using valuable space on the hard drive,

Storage Sense

- Storage sense monitors the system for old and unused files.
- It actively removes them on a regular schedule.

Example: files lying in the Recycle Bin for more than 30 days this feature will help take care of it.

Step to manage Storage Sense

- Turn on Storage Sense
- 1. Click the Start Menu.
- 2. Click Settings.
- 3. Click System.
- 4. Click Storage
- 5. Toggle Storage Sense **ON**.

- Patches are sent out more often than OS Updates.
 - Called Patch Tuesday.
 - Especially security-related patches!
 - Start by typing in the Search Bar 'Windows Update:'
 - Click 'Windows Update settings' in the pop-up menu.
 - Click 'Check for updates'.
 - Review the list of patches/ Updates Microsoft wants installed.

 - a PC takes longer to start up from Off mode.



Windows creates restore points: Automatically (3 conditions)

- When Windows Update installs new updates.
 - The Update just done can be undone. (Time Limit)
- When the user installs a driver that is not digitally signed by Windows Hardware Quality Labs.
- On user's command.
 - Set a restore point because of making a change to the PC.

Setting a restore Point

- Set a **System Restore** point when PC is Healthy Know How.
 - a. Can be used to recover from system malfunctions or other problems.

Note: that 'System Restore' will **NOT** delete files such as:

- Photos
- Documents.
- System Restore is not a good solution for removing viruses or other malware.

 - The factory SSID will identify the type of router.
 - Hackers knowledge (clear3475horizon = comcast router)

 - SSID and Password easily remembered.
 - Easily identify the wireless network.

A spill on the Device

- Do Not Shake It.
- Power OFF the device immediately.
 - Unplug the power cable and remove the battery, if possible.
- Turn It Upside Down and Let It Drain.(Laptop)
- Remove the SIM card (Phone) and the microSD, USB Flash Drive (PC).
- Put it in a bag of dry rice/ cereal, to absorb the remaining moisture. (Cell Phone)
- Don't wipe the PC, but leave the cloth or napkin to absorb the water. (24 to 48 hours)

A spill on the Device

- Do not use a Hair Dryer. (All devices)
- Do not use a Fan. (All devices)
- Water and green tea are at the better end of the spectrum.
- Drinks that include a lot of sugar and/or milk are at the bad end.
- Drinks often leave a residue when they dry.
- Try to blot rather than wipe;
 - bearing in mind that cloths and tissues can also leave residues.
- Take the laptop to a reputable service and repair shop;
 - to be disassembled, cleaned, and dried out.





- Windows 10 doesn't shut down normally.
 - It hibernates the Operating System,
 - saving its state so it can boot faster.
 - this is done by default
 - already set up in settings.
 - After reboot, these apps will re-open automatically.

Restart

- Shuts down all Apps and reloads Operating System/ Apps.
 - Can resolve problems or Pop-ups.
