



- Smartphone Telephone/Radio Circuitry
- > Smartphone Screen Size 4" to 6"
- ➤ Tablet Screen Size 7" to 12"



Shared Features

- > Touch-sensitive screen
- > 1+GHz multi-core processor
- Memory (Volatile, Non-Volatile)
- Rear-facing Camera (some)
- Front-facing Camera (most)
- > Accelerometer/Magnetometer




More Shared Features

- Wi-Fi (Wireless-Fidelity) (2.4GHz 802.11b/g/n) Microwave Apl frequency
- > GPS (Global Positioning System) (most)
- Bluetooth (many)
- ▶ USB (most)
- Micro SD memory slot (many)
- HDMI output (some)
- Headphone jack and built-in Speakers
- Microphone (phones obviously)
- Attachable Hardware keyboard (some Tablets)

What is the Internet?


A global communication network that allows computers worldwide to connect and exchange information.








▶ In the simplest terms, cloud computing just means storing and/or accessing data and programs over the Internet instead of using only your computer's local storage

- The Internet (A network of networks)
 - Employs <u>Client Server</u> Technology
 - Runs the TCP/IP set of protocols



Client – Server Technology

- A <u>network architecture</u> in which each computer in the network is a Client or a Server.
- A Server runs a server program and <u>shares</u> <u>its resources</u> with clients
- A client requests a server's action.
- <u>Clients initiate</u> communication sessions with servers which await incoming requests.
- Website computers act as <u>Servers</u>.
- Your device acts as the <u>Client</u>.



- Software as a Service
 - A software distribution model in which applications are hosted by a service provider and made available to customers over the Internet. (Windows 10?)
- Platform <u>as a Service</u>
 - Allows a customer to develop, run and manage web applications without building and maintaining hardware and software.
- Infrasturcture as a Service
 - provides all the equipment needed to support operations, including storage, hardware, servers and networking.

Apps vs. Computer Software

<u>Apps</u>

- Simple, single purpose
- Don't (usually) create files
- Data Consumer
- Easy to use
- > Few Instructions
- > \$10 and less

Software

- Complex, Multi-Function
- Typically create files

- Data Creator
- Need Tutoring
- User Manual
- > \$10 and much more

Apps & Widgets

> Apps

- <u>Software applications</u> designed to run on mobile devices, such as tablets and smartphones.
- Available through application distribution platforms, such as <u>Google Play</u> (and iTunes).
- Many apps are free, many others are under \$10.
- Downloaded directly to the target device.
 - (The term "app" has become very popular, and in 2010 was listed as "Word of the Year" by the American Dialect Society)

Apps & Widgets

> Widgets

- a small, single function computer program, that provides a <u>real-time display</u> of information.
- Examples are:
 - Clock, Calendar, Battery level
 - Weather (specific location)
 - Sports scores
- App vs. Widget
 - Apps need to be opened.
 - Widgets are always open, providing information

Originally, there were no Widgets in iOS

Downloading vs. Streaming

Downloading

 Receive a file, consisting of packets, and reconstruct the file and store it for future use

Streaming

 Receive a file, consisting of packets, and process the pieces as they are received (File is usually not stored)

Apps are Constantly Updated

- Automatic or Manual Updating
 - Go to the Google Play Store
 - Touch the Play Store Icon
 - Touch My Apps
 - Select App
 - Android 4.4 -Touch Menu
 >Check Auto Update
 - Check "Allow Automatic Updating" for automatic updates
 - Uncheck "Allow Automatic Updating" for manual updates






